Next Step with Johnson Street Bridge Following the results of the Alternative Approval Process, with 9,872 verified petitions, the City of Victoria has decided to postpone borrowing \$42 million to replace the aging Johnson Street Bridge.

Victoria City Council passed a motion at a special meeting, instructing staff to gather more information related to both replacement and refurbishment options, and to engage the public. The motion also states that Council will put bridge borrowing to a referendum at a date yet to be determined.
