Overview

Providing a voice to indigenous businesses, first nations and indigenous non-profit organizations

Mission

To foster economic reconciliation for the indigenous community using business to business connections and advocacy.

Objectives / Functions

- Identify/approve strategies to support/lift indigenous business in our region
- Determine member needs
- Categorize existing offerings
- Identify any gaps

Accountability

The CEO will report regularly as to the progress of work and make a final report to the Board.

Meetings

- Meetings are held at The Chamber office unless otherwise indicated

Accountability

- The Table facilitator will report to the CEO
- The CEO will provide a liaison/direction to the Public Policy & Advocacy Committee
- The CEO will review its Terms of Reference annually.

Supporting Resources

Internal staff resources will be provided for the Table, as determined by the CEO.

Process and outcomes

- The contracted facilitator will arrange for in person and virtual meetings between the CEO and Indigenous business owners
- Business choosing to join the Chamber will do so at no cost
- 2-3 Indigenous Business mixers/meetings will be facilitated each year
